**Programme of the Test of Admission to the English Language**

**Course 2019**

**General information**

The entry test comprises two parts, namely A and B. In part A participants will answer the questions in writing while in part B each candidate who will have passed part A is interviewed.

**Part A** will consist of three sections, namely:

- 1- Structure and written expression:** this section is designed to measure the candidate's ability to recognize language that is appropriate for Standard English;
- 2- Reading comprehension:** this section will assess the candidate's ability to understand written material and find out specific information;
- 3- Essay:** the candidate will be asked to produce a short essay on a topic of their choice (four topics will be suggested) to demonstrate their writing skills.

**The weighting will be as follows**

Section one: 80 marks

Section two: 60 marks

Section three: 60 marks

**Part B:** interview

Participants will be asked questions related to their general background, education, future plans, hobbies, etc.

3. Tenses and aspects (including tense sequence)
4. Pronouns
5. Prepositions
6. Determiners
7. Conjunctions
8. Comparative and superlative
